

In the interest of the safety of our residents and to avoid conflict with flight operations here at Naper Aero; and in keeping with the guidelines published by the FAA, the following procedures have been put into immediate effect in regards to UAV operations (Drone or Model Aircraft) at Naper Aero Club:

- 1. UAV operations must be in full compliance with any and all federal, state and local laws.
- 2. UAV operations must never be conducted in proximity of aircraft which are operating on the ground or while in any phase of flight within the traffic pattern of NAC.
- 3. In accordance with FAA guidelines, UAV operations should be coordinated with the Airport Manager.
- 4. UAV operations should never be conducted in any manner that would directly or indirectly impinge upon aircraft operations. This would include situations where a pilot of an operating aircraft might feel it necessary to divert from his/her intended flight path to avoid the possibility of collision.
- 5. UAV operations on airport property by non-residents are strictly prohibited
- 6. UAV operations shall never be conducted in any way that would cause injury or damage to any person or property at NAC. No flights over neighbor's property permitted
- 7. UAV operations shall not be conducted directly adjacent to the east west or north south runways.
- 8. If an individual is observed to operate a UAV in a manner that conflicts with any of these guidelines, the NAC board of directors may, at its discretion, report such activities to local law enforcement agencies with the intent of pursuing prosecution of said individual.
